Washington Watch

In an effort to keep our veterans informed, we will be highlighting key legislation and policy changes each month that impact veterans, their benefits, and their families.

VA offers 12-month community care authorizations for 30 specialty services, reducing the need for reauthorization every 90–180 days.

New mobile app feature: Veterans can now submit "mileage-only" travel reimbursement claims via the VA Health & Benefits app.

VA to reduce staff by nearly 30,000 in FY2025 through attrition, retirements, and hiring freeze (no large forced layoffs announced).

VA removes secondary review for community care authorizations, expediting access to non-VA care.
