In an effort to keep our veterans informed, we will be highlighting key legislation and policy changes each month that impact veterans, their benefits, and their families.

2025 Claims Processing & Benefit Access Improvements: The 2025 Federal Benefits Guide is now available online and in print. This comprehensive handbook covers everything from compensation and education benefits to mental health and home loans. The VA continues to expand access under the **PACT Act**, providing health care and disability support for toxic exposure, burn pits, and other service-related hazards.

VA Budget Surpasses \$400 Billion in 2025: Due to rising costs for mandated benefits and toxic exposure care, the VA's 2025 budget has exceeded \$400 billion, marking a significant increase from previous years.
